Weather Situation

A high pressure system lies over northern Victoria. A weak cold front will cross southern Victoria during Sunday. From Monday, another high pressure system will move over the Bight.

Forecast for the rest of Saturday 28 June

Partly cloudy. Light winds.

Forecast for Sunday 29 June

Cloudy. Areas of frost and the chance of fog in the morning. Slight chance of a shower. Snow possible above 1300 metres. Light winds. Overnight temperatures falling to between minus 2 and 1 above zero with daytime temperatures reaching between 9 and 13.

Seymour Morning frost. Cloudy. Min -1 Max 13

Sun protection not recommended, UV Index predicted to reach 1 [Low]

Forecast for Monday 30 June

Partly cloudy. Slight chance of a shower. Snow possible above 1300 metres. Areas of morning frost in the east. Winds southerly 15 to 20 km/h. Overnight temperatures falling to around 2 with daytime temperatures reaching between 10 and 13.

Seymour Partly cloudy. Min 3 Max 13

Forecast for Tuesday 1 July

Partly cloudy. Areas of morning frost in the east. Slight chance of a shower in the east, near zero chance elsewhere. Snow possible above 1300 metres. Winds southerly 15 to 25 km/h. Overnight temperatures falling to between zero and 3 with daytime temperatures reaching between 10 and 14.

Seymour Mostly sunny. Min 3 Max 13

Forecast for Wednesday 2 July

Partly cloudy. Slight chance of a shower. Winds southerly 20 to 30 km/h. Overnight temperatures falling to around 3 with daytime temperatures reaching between 9 and 13.

Seymour Partly cloudy. Min 4 Max 14
