A high pressure system lies over northern Victoria. A weak cold front will cross southern Victoria during Sunday. From Monday, another high pressure system will move over the Bight.

Forecast for the rest of Saturday 28 June

Clear. Light winds.

Forecast for Sunday 29 June

Partly cloudy. Areas of frost and the chance of fog in the morning. Slight chance of a shower in the south, near zero chance elsewhere. Snow possible above 1300 metres. Light winds. Overnight temperatures falling to between minus 4 and minus 1 with daytime temperatures reaching between 8 and 13.

Overnight temperatures falling to between minus 2 and 1 above zero with daytime temperatures reaching between 9 and 15.
